

# Undergraduate enrollment

**1. Q : I want to study in JiangSu University for an undergraduate degree. So is there any scholarship available?**

A : Jiangsu University offers the following scholarships to international undergraduates:

## 1.1. Chinese Government Scholarship

Chinese government scholarship applicants should apply through the Chinese Embassy or consulate General in the applicant's home country.

**2. Q: How soon will I know whether I am accepted or not after I submit my application?**

A: Jiangsu University will select students in batches based on their high school scores, language proficiency, interviews or written tests, etc. Admission time is about 3-5 working days. Please pay attention to the mailbox in the application system and check the application result in the system.

**3. Q: What are the requirements for bank statements?**

A: The account name of the bank statement must be the same as the financial guarantor information in the application system. It is recommended to be an immediate family member, sibling or spouse, etc. The bank statement should be issued within 6 months and the closing balance should not be less than 40,000 RMB.

**4. Q: Can I substitute HSK or IELTS or TOEFL scores with language certificates issued by the school?**

A: HSK scores are required to apply for majors taught in Chinese. In principle, IELTS and TOEFL scores are required to apply for majors taught in English. Due to various factors, certificates of Teaching in English issued by schools can be used as application materials at present.

**5. Q: Does Jiangsu University accept transfer students?**

A: Jiangsu University does not accept international transfer students. If you want to study in Jiangsu University, you should apply for our university as a new student after completing the withdrawal formalities of your original school.

**6. Q: What are the for rules period of schooling during the undergraduate period?**

A: The period of schooling is divided into four years and six years according to major. Foreign students are subject to the flexible learning period system under the prescribed schooling system. The minimum learning period for four-year and six-year undergraduate students is three and five years respectively. For those who fail to graduate on time, the maximum extension of the basic period of schooling can be two years (including suspension of schooling and retention of school status for exchange students)

**7. Q: Can the courses taken in other schools be recognized in Jiangsu University?**

A: International students who have taken the same courses in other

universities (including overseas) can apply for credit recognition. Credit recognition procedures shall be implemented in accordance with the relevant regulations on credit recognition management of undergraduate international teaching of Jiangsu University.

**8. Can the student apply to transfer major who learn the original major with difficulties?**

A: Students can apply students can apply individually before registering, the admissions office of Overseas Education College reviews the study background. Students who meet the enrollment requirements of the major to be transferred can agree to transfer to another major. International students who have already registered can apply for a new major according to the "Implementation Measures of Jiangsu University for Undergraduate Students to Change Majors".

**9. Q: What are the basic requirements for graduation and conferring a degree?**

A: International students who have completed the courses of the registered major within the prescribed period of time and have reached the Level 4 of the International Standard of Chinese Proficiency (180 points or above in the New HSK Level 4) are allowed to graduate and will be issued a graduation certificate by the University. Students who meet the requirements of the training program and have a GPA of 1.80 or above can be awarded a bachelor's degree.

3. How soon will I know whether I am accepted or not after I submit my application?

5. How do I get information about my major or professor?

6. Do I need to contact the relevant tutor at the application stage? How should contact?

Master and Doctoral applicants are advised to contact their tutors by email or other means during the application phase. You can send your CV, PS and other relevant documents to your tutor. If the applicant can obtain an acceptance letter from the instructor, please attach it to the application materials by mail. If not, you also can apply.

7. Do I have to provide the tutor's acceptance letter?

Not necessarily.

8. What are the requirements for bank statements?

The account name of the bank statement must be the same as the financial guarantor information in the application system. It is recommended to be an immediate family member, sibling or spouse, etc. The bank statement should be issued within 6 months and the closing balance should not be less than 30,000 RMB.

9. Do students need to register for each semester after registration?

Students are required to complete semester registration in the online Student Portal at the beginning of each semester.

10. Once a course has been selected in the system, can make changes again?

Once a course is finalized, students cannot change it at will. This can only be changed if some courses are not taught for two consecutive semesters. If the relevant course is not running, please check with the School Secretary and contact the International Education Office for a

course adjustment form. Once a course is locked, students cannot change or add courses, only optional course can be adjusted.

11. When can students submit papers for concealed evaluation?

Doctoral students can submit their dissertation for concealed evaluation 16 months after the thesis proposal defense is successful, and master students can submit their dissertation 8 months after the thesis proposal defense is successful. Students can only submit in the last semester of their studies and are usually not allowed to graduate early.

12. What is the importance of HSK?

Students are required to pass the HSK exam before submitting their thesis for concealed evaluation.
